Materials – what something is made from.

Wood – hard material from a tree.

Plastic – easily moulded material when soft.

Glass – transparent material usually used for bottles and windows.

Metal - a solid material which is typically hard and shiny. Good electrical and thermal conductivity

Fabric – mainly used to make clothing.

Rubber – tough and elastic material used for things like tyres.

Opaque – something you cannot see through. (wood)

Transparent - something you can see through. (glass)
